USPA Circuit Championships

The USPA Circuit Championships are the final event of the calendar year of the USPA Circuit. The championships are designed to bring the eight best performing pairs together in a very competitive and high level tournament.

The eight pairs will be divided two groups of four. The pairs in each group will play each other in a round robin, with the top two pairs in each division progressing to the semi-finals.

Rules and Regulations - The circuit championships will follow the FIP and USPA rules of FIP, unless stated otherwise below

- Players enter with any partner they want.
- Players may change partners after they have entered, but prior to the deadline, by emailing info@padelusa.org
- All players must have played a USPA circuit tournament during the calendar year.
- The entry deadline is Thursday 12 noon, two weeks prior to the start of the championship.
- The pairs are ranked based on combined ranking, lowest ranking is at the top of the list.
- The entry list will be published with the top eight teams and additional teams on a waitlist.

Withdraws after the entry deadline, but 7 days prior to the championship.

- If a player withdraws for any reason, their partner may find a replacement for them.

 The remaining player and the new partner must have a low enough combined ranking to be ahead of the first team on the waitlist. If they are not, then the first team on the waitlist is entered into the draw.
- The player whose partner withdrew, may ask players who are on the waitlist to be their partner, and the player from the waitlist, may choose to leave their partner from the waitlist to join the draw.

Withdraws inside 7 days prior to the championship.

- If a player withdraws for any reason, the entire team is withdrawn and the first team on the waitlist will be invited to enter the draw.
- If a team withdraws after the tournament has started for any reason, there will be no replacement, and the scores from none of their matches will be counted.
