

FIP Tournament Registration / Create Padel Uno

Registration is a multi-step process, and players are strongly encouraged to register 7 days before the deadline to prevent last-minute issues that may prevent them from registering.

To register for a PadelUno account, you must have a national license number from the same country as your passport. If you live in the USA but do not have a U.S. passport, you must first obtain a national license number from the national federation of your passport country. You should contact them directly for this. For example, if your passport is from Mexico, contact the FEMEPA

Step 1. [Create \(or sign into\) the athlete's USA Padel Account at this link.](#) Your USA Padel Player ID will serve as your National License Number and your temporary FIP License Number.

Setting up an account does require FIP approval, which can take up to 48 hours. If you do not receive the confirmation email, email competition@padelifp.com

Step 3. Ensure that your proposed partner has also completed steps 1 and 2 and received an Uno account approval email from FIP.

Step 4. Both players must register for the tournament and select (or approve) their partner.

Step 5. Make payment for the tournament entry fee directly with the host club
